Crimson Ruby® has deep, rich, burgundy-red foliage. To add interesting color and texture to the landscape, consider planting it with dark green evergreens such as Boxwood or English Holly. Other combinations might include planting with a soft complimenting blue color of Blue Star and Blue Pacific Junipers or the contrasting bright gold of Bonanza Gold® barberry or spiraea.

For best color be sure to plant in full sun. Crimson Ruby® will flourish in most well-drained soils, prefers a moist location with a recommended 6.0 to 7.5 pH and is hardy to USDA Zone 4.
